



The International Gorilla Conservation Programme (IGCP) is a coalition programme of Fauna & Flora International and WWF with the mission to conserve gorillas and their habitat through partnering with key stakeholders to significantly contribute to sustainable livelihood development. IGCP works in partnership with the Protected Area Authorities in the Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda, and Uganda and with the framework for transboundary collaboration provided for in the emerging Greater Virunga Transboundary Collaboration (GVTC). Partnership extends to the private sector, civil society, local and national government agencies, and other NGOs and institutions.
